Mattie's Call Issued for Stephanie Edwards

The Clayton County Police Department is seeking assistance in the whereabouts of Ms. Stephanie Edwards.

WHAT: Mattie's Call Issued for Stephanie Edwards

WHEN: August 31, 2020 at 1950 hours

WHERE: 11 Upper Riverdale Rd., Riverdale, GA 30274

DETAILS: On 08/31/2020 at 2240 hours, Clayton County Police officers responded to a missing persons call at Southern Regional Medical Center at 11 Upper Riverdale Rd. Officers learned Stephanie Edwards (DOB: 07/24/1955) walked away from the location at approximately 1950 hours. Ms. Edwards has been diagnosed with Dementia.

Ms. Edwards is a sixty-five-year old black female with black hair and brown eyes. Ms. Edwards is 5'3" in height and weighs 120 pounds. Ms. Edwards was last seen wearing a black/white/red t-shirt, black jeans, black baseball cap and carrying a brown purse.
