WHAT: Mattie's Call issued for Sredrick Cook

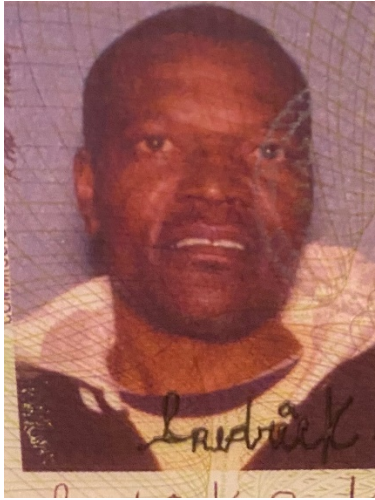
WHEN: November 29, 2020 @ 2000 hours

WHERE: 2800 Block of Heritage Lane Morrow, GA 30260 (Clayton County, GA)

DETAILS:

On December 09, 2020, Clayton County Police Department Officers responded to a missing person's call. Officers learned on November 25, 2020 at approximately 12:00 p.m., Sredrick Cook who is 54 years old, left his home located in the 2800 Block of Heritage Ln Morrow, GA 30260. He walked away from the location without telling anyone he was leaving. Mr. Cook's cousin, Ms. Lewis has been trying to get in contact with him since he left the house. Mr. Cook is suffering from Bipolar Schizophrenia and Ms. Lewis has attempted to locate Mr. Cook on her own but was not successful and called law enforcement. Mr. Cook has not taken his medications in over a month. Mr. Cook was placed on GCIC as a missing person. A Mattie's Call was initiated by the Georgia Bureau of Investigation. If you have any information on the whereabouts of Sredrick Cook, notify local law enforcement and Clayton County Police Department at 770-477-3747.
