Mattie's Call issued for Ayesha O'Neal

The Clayton County Police Department is seeking assistance in the whereabouts of Ms. Ayesha O'Neal

WHAT: Mattie's Call issued for Ayesha O'Neal

WHEN: November 29, 2020 @ 2000 hours

WHERE: 200 block of Upper Riverdale Road, Riverdale, GA 30296 (Clayton County, GA)

DETAILS:

On November 29, 2020, Clayton County Police Department Officers responded to a missing person's call. Officers learned Ayesha O'Neal left the location on foot at approximately 2000 hours after an altercation with her mother. Ms. O'Neal has a history of running away. Ms. O'Neal has been diagnosed with Schizophrenia and Bipolar disorder.

Ms. O'Neal is described as a 15-year-old black female with black/brown braids and brown eyes. Ms. O'Neal is 5'06" in height and weighs approximately 150 lbs. Ms. O'Neal was last seen wearing red/black jacket, red puma shoes, and a tan scarf.
