Mattie's Call Issued for Dytisha Smith

The Clayton County Police Department is seeking assistance in the whereabouts of Ms. Dytisha Smith.

WHAT: Mattie's Call issued for Dytisha Smith

WHEN: July 20, 2020 at 1900 hours

WHERE: 5432 River Station Blvd., Atlanta, GA 30349 (Clayton County)

DETAILS: On 07/20/2020 at 1900 hours, Clayton County Police officers responded to a missing persons call at the Wayfield Foods at 5432 River Station Blvd., Atlanta, GA 30349. Officers learned Dytisha Smith (DOB: 09/22/1992) walked away from the location at 1200 hours after getting off work. Ms. Smith is not known to walk away from work and is picked up daily. Ms. Smith has been diagnosed with a learning disability, depression, anxiety as well as schizophrenia.

Ms. Smith is a twenty-seven-year old black female with brown hair and brown eyes. Ms. Smith is 5'7" in height and weighs 220 pounds. Ms. Smith was last seen wearing a white t-shirt, khaki pants, blue sweater with Minnie Mouse written on the sleeves and a white apron that reads, "Wayfield Foods."
