The Clayton County Police Department is seeking assistance in the whereabouts of Ms. Ayesha O'Neal

WHAT: Mattie's Call issued for Ayesha O'Neal

WHEN: October 24, 2020 @ 0830 hours

WHERE: 276 Upper Riverdale Road, Riverdale, GA 30296 (Clayton County, GA)

DETAILS:

On October 24, 2020, Clayton County Police Department Officers responded to a missing person's call. Officers learned Ayesha O'Neal (DOB: 09/06/2005) left the location on foot at approximately 0830 hours. Ms. O'Neal has a history of running away. Ms. O'Neal has been diagnosed with Schizophrenia and Bipolar disorder.

Ms. O'Neal is described as a 15-year-old black female with brown hair and brown eyes. Ms. O'Neal is 5'01" in height and weighs approximately 140 lbs. Ms. O'Neal was last seen wearing black shorts, a black hoodie, one black flip flop and one brown flip flop.
