Mattie's Call Issued for Chantel Jefferson
09/02/2020 – (Riverdale, GA)

The Clayton County Police Department is seeking assistance in the whereabouts of Ms. Chantel Jefferson.

WHAT: Mattie's Call Issued for Chantel Jefferson

WHEN: August 18, 2020 at 0745 hours

WHERE: 1600 block of E. Fayetteville Rd., Riverdale, GA 30296

DETAILS: On 09/02/2020 at 0900 hours, Clayton County Police officers responded to a missing person call at the 1600 block E. Fayetteville Rd. Officers learned Chantel Jefferson (DOB: 04/05/1984) has not been seen since her husband dropped her off at the Amtrack train station (Atlanta, GA) on 08/18/2020 for a trip to New York. Her husband stated he spoke to her when she arrived in New York and for several days afterwards. Ms. Jefferson has not been in contact with her husband via phone since 08/28/2020. Ms. Jefferson has been diagnosed with Bipolar Disorder and Schizophrenia.

Ms. Jefferson is a thirty-six-year old black female with black hair and brown eyes. Ms. Jefferson is 5'11" in height and weighs 140 pounds. Ms. Jefferson was last seen wearing blue jeans and a white shirt.
